

e-Learning HAZOP Awareness

Target Audience

This course is aimed at managers, designers, operators and maintenance personnel, needing a general understanding of the HAZOP process. The course is also a suitable refresher course for people who have been previously trained in HAZOP.

Objective:

The objective of this course is to provide a general awareness of the HAZOP process and to provide limited guidance regarding the implementation of the HAZOP processes.

Course Content:

The course is intended to initiate participants into the HAZOP process. The HAZOP process is called for in several Acts and Regulations, and therefore is one of a range of possible legal plant design safety milestones which must be incorporated to satisfy regulatory requirements:

- Regulatory requirements for conducting
- HAZOPs
- AS IEC 61882-2003. Hazard and operability studies
- Types of HAZOPs and their objectives
- When to do HAZOPs in project life cycles
- HAZOP environment and process
- Team member selection and team roles
- Guide words and their meanings
- HAZOP limitations

Course Length:

Approximately 2 hours. This course is self-paced. Participants can go into and out of the course as many times as they wish until such time the course is completed.

Outcome:

A Certificate of Completion will be issued together with a Handbook that supports the information covered during the course.
